Business Office News

Registration materials for the 2017/2018 school year will be mailed soon. Please be aware of deadlines. Registration fees are \$25/child before May 1. After May 1, the fee increases to \$50/child.

Day Care/Early Arrival Parents – Please remember day care and early arrival charges are due upon receipt. Finance charges will be assessed to any account over \$10 on the last day of the month. If your account balance is below \$5, you will not receive a day care billing statement.

FINANCIAL AID INFORMATION: Student Tuition Organization (STO) applications for financial assistance will be mailed soon. **Submit applications directly to the Notre Dame Business Office by April 15, 2017.** Include page 1 and 2 of your 2016 Federal Income tax return. No fee is required. No STO funding will be awarded if applications are postmarked after April 15. Applicants must be lowa residents and are available to parents with children in grades K -12.

Applications for the Dehner and Fichtenkort Scholarships are now available in the Business Office. The deadline for these scholarships is May 15. Awards are made to students of Catholic Faith and who are members of a Des Moines County parish.

All financial aid applications can be picked up in the Business Office. A copy of your 2016 Federal Income tax return must accompany all scholarship applications. Deadlines for financial assistance other than STO are May 15, 2017. All financial obligations for tuition, day care, early arrival, hot lunch and library fines must be met prior to receiving financial assistance for the 2017/2018 school year.

Scrip News

Your May tuition statement will reflect your Scrip tuition credit from purchases April 1, 2016 through March 31, 2017. 2% of every purchase goes toward your Scrip tuition credit. The more you buy, they more credit you earn! Stop by the Business Office for any details or questions about the program. Scrip is sold after all Masses at Ss. Mary & Patrick and at Ss. John & Paul parishes. Large inventories are kept in the Elementary and Business Office so Scrip is accessible to everyone.

The reason for the effectiveness of Scrip is simple: families generate revenue through purchases they would make anyway. Groceries, clothing, toys, gifts; even gasoline can be purchased with Scrip. ND families can easily spend between one and two million dollars per year on food, clothing and other essentials. If 100% of Notre Dame Families use Scrip for these purchases, ND could raise \$70,000 to \$150,000 per year without spending an additional penny. Be Cool! Help Our School and Participate!
